Ballet Arts offers an extensive range of education



and exercise including **Ballet with piano accompaniment**, Jazz, Tap, Ballroom, Irish Step, Hip-Hop, Boy's Classes, Modern, Creative Movement, Story Time Dance, Musical Theater, Latin/Salsa and Adult Classes. Classes are available for students age 2 to Adult in every skill level, beginner to advanced. Placements are at discretion of the director. Private voice and musical instrument lessons.

Enrollment in our program is for the full school year; September to the Recital (typically the first or second weekend in June)

Tuition Payment Schedule: Tuition is due in three parts; one third at registration, one third by November 15th and one third by January 15th. \$50 recital fee is due at registration. Tuition and recital fee are non-refundable.

*Ask about an automated recurring billing plan.

2 individual classes taken per week is 5% off on the third payment per child. 3 individual classes taken per week is 10% off on the 3rd payment per child. Excludes private lessons, 10 consecutive week classes, extra pointe classes, and Junior and Senior companies.

Package A: For 1½ hours, 15 children or less - \$375

Includes a teacher to teach or play with the children for the first 45 minutes. You come 1/2 hour before your party begins and decorate to your own taste. Bring your own food and drinks and we clean up. A deposit of \$175 is non-refundable and the balance is due the day of the party. After 15 children there is an additional charge of \$10 per child.

Package B: For 1½ hours, 15 children or less - \$550

Includes entertainment for the children for the first 45 minutes, a meal and birthday cake and additional entertainment, time permitting. We decorate, supply pizza or sandwiches and drinks for the children along with a balloon and party bag for each child. DRESS CODE

Unadorned traditional attire from recognized specialty dance manufacturers is required for class. No shimmery tights or pantyhose.

Girls' Ballet, Pre-School, Kindergarten & IA: Ballet pink, long-sleeved scoop-neck leotard, ballet pink tights and ballet pink slippers. Hair in a ballet bun. No skirts or designs on the leotard.

Girls' Ballet I, II, Ill: Black long-sleeved scoop-neck leotard, ballet pink tights and ballet pink slippers. All hair must be pulled back in a ballet bun. No skirts or design on the leotard.

Girls' Ballet IV: A specific black So Danca camisole leotard, ballet pink tights and ballet pink slippers. All hair must be pulled back in a ballet bun. No skirts or legwarmers. Dance sweaters are allowed.

Girls' Ballet V, VI: Black camisole leotard, ballet pink tights and ballet pink slippers. All hair must be pulled back in a ballet bun. No skirts or design on the leotard.

Boys' Ballet, all levels: White short-sleeved T-shirt, black tights or shorts and black ballet slippers.

Girls' Jazz and Tap Beginner, IA and I: Black long-sleeved scoopneck leotard, black tights, and black jazz shoes/black tap shoes with double taps. All hair in a pony tail.

Jazz II & III & Tap II: Black jazz pants and black long-sleeved leotard with appropriate shoes. All hair in a pony tail.

Boys' Jazz and Tap: Black shorts, solid color T-shirt, black jazz shoes or black tap shoes with double taps.

Flamenco: Black Flamenco Skirt, character or flamenco shoes.

Ballroom: Leather or suede bottom shoes.

Girls' Irish Step: Black shorts, white shirt. Beginner-black ballet slippers, Advanced Beginner-gillies, Novice-gillies and hard shoes. Prize Winner-gillies and hard shoes. All hair tied in a pony tail.

Boys' Irish Step: Black shorts, white shirt. Beginner–black jazz shoes, Novice–Jazz shoes and hard shoes. Prize Winner–jazz shoes and hard shoes.

Hip-Hop: Hip-Hop pants and shoes through Centre Stage.

Boy's Hip-Hop: Hip-Hop pants and shoes through Centre Stage.

Creative Movement: For girls, ballet pink, long-sleeve, tank or camisole leotard, ballet pink tights and ballet pink slippers. Pink skirt or tutu. All hair must be pulled back in a ballet bun.

Latin/Rhythms: Comfortable clothes and Jazz shoes for men and character shoes for women.


GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Enrollment in our program is for the full school year; September to the Recital (typically the first or second weekend in June). Tuition is due in three parts; one third at registration, one third by November 15th and one third by January 15th. All tuition fees include registration and administrative fee. **All tuitions are not refundable.**¹
- 2. Please make checks payable to Centre Stage at Ballet Arts LLC. A processing fee for credit card payments will be applied. A late payment penalty of 5% of the outstanding balance will automatically accrue every 30 days.²
- 3. Centre Stage at Ballet Arts LLC accepts students through January 31, 2019 unless a class is closed due to maximum enrollment.
- 4. A \$50 non-refundable recital fee is due at registration.
- 5. The Ballet Arts Program follows the Pelham Public School System for closings, including holidays and related closings.³ For complete schedule of no classes, go to the website www.ballet-arts.net.
- 6. All dance, gymnastics, ice skating, fitness, yoga, pilates and cheerleading essentials are available thru Centre Stage.

- 7. Class Make-ups: to be eligible for a make-up notice must be given. Only 4 make-ups are permitted; no make-ups after January 31st, 2019.
- 8. Private Lessons: Any cancellation requires 24 hour notice or you will be charged in full.
- 9. Our dress code is strictly enforced.
- 10. Mrs. Daniele reserves the right to dismiss a student for nonpayment, tardiness, excessive absences or inappropriate behavior.
- 11. Pro-rating tuition begins October 22, 2018.
- 12. All rehearsals are mandatory. Chronic absences during recital preparation (after January 31st) will result in the student being dismissed from recital or will require private lesson make-up at an additional fee.
- 13. Schedule and staff subject to change.


